Vergina-King Philip Royal Tomb

January 7 (included in the Spring 2024 Study Abroad program)

** Cost €50 includes:
Includes Bus transportation, entrance fee, guided tour and lunch.*

A day trip to the area of Ancient Aegai and a visit to the museum of Vergina which houses the tombs and treasures of members of the Macedonian Royal Dynasty, including the tomb of King Philip II, father of Alexander the Great.



Pozar Hot Springs

January 20 & March 3

Cost €30 includes: Visit of the Edessa Waterfall, Transportation to Pozar – "Loutra Arideas", Entrance ticket to the outdoor pool and hot waterfall.



A day trip to the Thermal (Medicinal) Baths of Pozar (near the city of Edessa). Pozar has natural hot springs which maintain a constant temperature of 37°C. Visitors arrive from all over Greece to delve the beneficial properties of the mineral-filled waters. You can choose to swim in the large outdoor hot pool, the hot waterfall along the river or several different indoor pools. Bathing suit recommended. Bring money for snacks and lunch.

Meteora 2-Day Trip

February 3-4

Cost €100 includes: Transportation, Accommodation in Ioannina (breakfast incl.), Perama cave visit, 2 Monasteries visit, and Faculty guide.



A weekend trip to Thessaly region to visit 2 of the Meteora monasteries impressively built during the middle ages on the peak of very high rocks and protected as a UNESCO World Heritage site. In the Epirus region we will visit the 1200m long "Perama cave" in Ioannina with impressive stalactites and stalagmites. We will stay overnight in Ioannina, a magnificent historic town with a beautiful castle and a lake in the center of the town.

Meteora Monasteries Day Trip

February 25

Cost €50 includes: Transportation, 2 Monasteries visit, Lunch.

A day trip to 2 of the Meteora monasteries impressively built during the middle ages on the peak of very high rocks and protected as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Lunch in the town of Kalambaka (incl.).

Mt Olympus Day Hikes

March 9 & 10

Cost €50 includes: Transportation, mountain guide.



A day hike on the picturesque northeast slopes of Mt. Olympus. Four hours of moderate walking through "Enipeas" canyon. Sturdy shoes required. Bring snacks, water and money for lunch.

3 Day Sailing Trip

March 23-25

(limit to 8 people/sailboat)

Cost €350 includes: 3 sailing days, 2 nights on the boat, food, skipper transportation to/from port.



*This is a 3-day sailing trip in the area of Halkidiki, Greece. No previous sailing experience is required - each boat has a professional skipper. Relax, explore the beaches and harbors, and enjoy living on the sailboat. You can also take an active role in handling the boat under the skipper's watchful eye and direction. The excursion will start and end in Thessaloniki.
