Notice for the use for Photographs and Videos for ACT – American College of Thessaloniki

This Notice does not apply to photographs that are taken / provided by staff and students for identification purposes, as part of the Institution's obligation to ensure their safety and security and to prevent fraudulent activity (e.g. exam or other identification).

The purpose of this Notice is to provide background information regarding our request to get specific consent for the use and publish images, photos and video recordings capturing students, during their studies, academic and extracurricular activities at ACT – American College of Thessaloniki and events.

The **Anatolia College, as the Data Controller**, is committed to respect your privacy and personal data, and has complied with the **General Data Protection Regulation/ GDPR (EU) 2016/679** and the applicable laws. Photos and videos are taken by the official photographer of Anatolia College/ACT faculty, staff, and in some cases students, and they are stored and secured in Anatolia College/ACT databases and equipment, for educational and archival purposes.

Additionally, photos and recordings may appear in Anatolia College printed and online magazines, newsletters, website articles, Anatolia College and ACT official social media pages, in Press Releases. Furthermore, they may appear in promotional material of the institution.

In order to use an individual photo, image, or video recording for the above mentioned purposes we need your freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous consent as required from the EU-General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679, dated April 27th 2016, Anatolia College Privacy Notice, and all applicable laws and regulations.

We believe that the photographs, recordings or videos that ACT, the tertiary division of Anatolia College, takes have a positive influence our students' confidence, and strengthen the bonds between the students and the institution.

This Notice does not apply in the cases of group photos or photographs where the individuals cannot be identified or appear incidentally in the background of publicity shots and they are clearly not the focus of the image, such as in crowd scenes. We wish to remind you that once consent has been given or refused, this can be amended at any time in writing. The institution will then take all reasonable efforts to enact this request as quickly as possible.

You can withdraw your consent for this at any time by submitting the request to privacy@anatolia.edu.gr. This will not apply to material already published. Anatolia College and ACT cannot control already published material or recall it.
